

## Northamptonshire Highways

### Silverstone, Brackley Road /Towcester Road – Carriageway resurfacing

**Start date** – Monday 21 June 2021

**Completion** – Saturday 04 July 2021

Only weekdays and one Saturday.

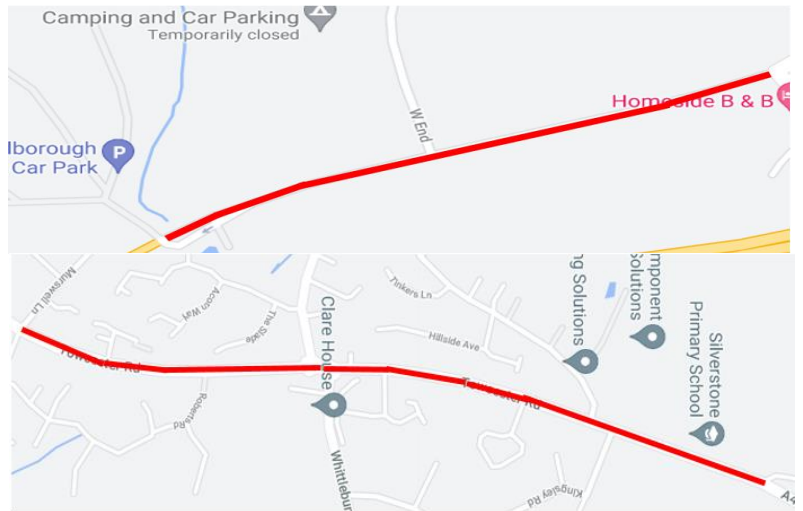
(Weather dependent)

**Scheme type** – Carriageway resurfacing on Brackley Road between Hazelborough Wood Car Park and Dadford Road.

Towcester Road between Murswell Lane and national speed limit terminal signs.

**Traffic management** – Full road closure

**Hours of work** – 09:00 – 16:30



**What we are doing/the benefits** – Northamptonshire Highways will soon start resurfacing works on Brackley Road and Towcester Road. These works will improve the structural stability of the road, increase skid resistance and improve safety for road users. Works include resetting of ironworks where required, and installation of road markings and installing high friction surfacing. We will also clean gullies to ensure we make the best use of the closure and to minimise disruption for residents in the future, in addition we will carry out vegetation clearance on Brackley Road.

#### **COVID-19 message**

These Government identified key workers are carrying out essential highway works for us, whilst maintaining social distancing and following all COVID-19 guidelines to ensure the health and safety of our workforce and residents.

Northamptonshire Highways, its contractors and suppliers are identified as key workers as defined by the government: “***those who will keep the air, water, road and rail passenger and freight transport modes operating during the Covid-19 response including those in supply chains***”, and that these works have been defined as essential works by the government.

Our priority is to keep the highway network open and safe. We are also working to keep on programme with highway works to improve communities and repair roads

We would like to assure you that all of our site teams have been extensively briefed on all Government Guidance regarding social distancing, increased cleanliness, and working within communities. The Government has also permitted that workers, where necessary, may be in groups of more than two to undertake works and that, whilst the 2-meter physical distancing rule should always try and be achieved, this would not always be practicable.

To eliminate the need to knock on doors and help us with our work, please could you move any vehicles parked along the route of our operations. Thank you for your understanding, patience, and co-operation.

#### **Traffic Management**

When programming works, we consider the impact on all network users and plan our works to minimise disruption as much as possible. Highlighted in **RED** is the extend of works area and road closures as per the above map.

### Silverstone, Brackley Road /Towcester Road – Carriageway resurfacing

During the road closure please use the fully signed diversion route, which will use the A43.

#### **Information for residents**

**Access:** We aim to maintain access for emergency vehicles ONLY.

During working hours, vehicle access will be restricted for residents of Brackley Road, Towcester Road and the adjacent cul-de-sacs and side streets. We have personnel on site to help you.

**Egress:** During working hours, vehicle egress will be restricted. Operatives on site will escort you safely through the site. If possible, please plan your journeys outside our working hours, as there will be prolonged delays depending on the activities on front of your property.

**Businesses:** We ask that during the works people park legally on the nearest side street and walk to any businesses affected by the closure.

**Pedestrians:** During the works, pedestrians will not be affected. There are pedestrian marshals will be on site to assist.

**Cyclist:** Cyclists will be asked to dismount and walk through the site on the footpath.

#### **Phasing**

The following road closures will be in place in the following phases:

**Phase 1 - Monday 21 June:** Work area between Hazelborough Wood Car Park and Dadford Road junction. Carriageway resurfacing (planing existing surface), resetting of ironworks, installation of temporary road marking and vegetation clearance. No vehicle access to Hazelborough Wood Car Park, West End and residents of Brackley Road between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

**Phase 1 – Tuesday 22 June:** Work area between Hazelborough Wood Car Park and Dadford Road junction. Carriageway resurfacing (laying surface course) and installation of road marking. No vehicle access to Hazelborough Wood Car Park, West End and residents of Brackley Road between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

**Phase 2 – Wednesday 23 June:** Work area between Whittlebury Road and Lay-by. Carriageway resurfacing (planing existing surface), resetting of ironworks and installation of temporary road marking; No vehicle access to residents of Towcester Road and Silverstone Primary school, Kingsley Road, Little London, Paddock Close, Lime Kiln Close, between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

**Phase 2 – Thursday 24 June:** Work area between Little London Road and Murswell Lane junction. Carriageway resurfacing (planing existing surface), resetting of ironworks and installation of temporary road marking. No vehicle access to residents of Towcester Road, Whittlebury Road, Paddock Close, Lime Kiln Close, Baines Close, Roberts Road and Bovis Homes construction site between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

**Phase 2 - Friday 25 June:** Work area between Little London Road and Lay-by. Carriageway resurfacing (laying surface course) and installation of road marking. No vehicle access to residents of Towcester Road, Silverstone Primary school, Kingsley Road and Little London and between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

**Phase 2 – Monday 28 June:** Work area between Little London Road and Whittlebury Road junction. Carriageway resurfacing (laying surface course) aND installation of road marking. No vehicle access to residents of Towcester Road, Paddock Close, Lime Kiln Close between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

**Phase 2 – Tuesday 29 June:** Work area between Whittlebury Road and Murswell Lane junction. Carriageway resurfacing (paving surface course) AND installation of road marking. No vehicle access

to residents of Towcester Road, Roberts Road, Baines Close and Bovis Homes construction site between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

Phase 3 – Wednesday 30 June: Work area between Whittlebury Road and Lay-by. Installation of High Friction Surface. No vehicle access to residents of Towcester Road and Silverstone Primary School, Kingsley Road, Little London, Paddock Close, Lime Kiln Close, between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

Phase 3 – Thursday 1 July: Work area between Whittlebury Road and Lay-by. Installation of High Friction Surface. No vehicle access to residents of Towcester Road and Silverstone Primary school, Kingsley Road, Little London, Paddock Close, Lime Kiln Close, between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

Phase 3 – Friday 2 July: Work area between Little London Road and Murswell Lane junction. Installation of High Friction Surface. No vehicle access to residents of Towcester Road, Whittlebury Road, Paddock Close, Lime Kiln Close, Baines Close, Roberts Road & and New construction site between 09:00 to 16:30 hours.

Phase 4 – Saturday 3 July: Work area between Hazelborough Wood Car Park on Brackley Road and the Lay-by on Towcester road. Gully emptying throughout the village main road, works will be carried out under 'Stop & Go' traffic management.

#### **Towaway – moving vehicles parked in our workspace.**

We have been working with the local authority and have agreed that parked vehicles that are preventing or hindering the works taking place, may be relocated to an adjacent street.

An approved contractor will carry this out and vehicles will be moved to a nearby street.

Please look out for the signs as shown on the right. These signs will be located on your street detailing the closure dates. We ask that you park away from our works area during these times.
