7	DETERMINATION OF THE COUNCIL'S RESPONSE TO APPLICATION S/2019/0711/RES as detailed at (4) above:-								
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Site access hours are restricted to between 7.30am and 6pm. The site should not be open outwith these times and that those working onsite are respectful of neighbouring properties by keeping unnecessary noise to a minimum. 								

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A structural survey is carried out under Green Lane to ascertain which services are there and how they may be affected by the level and weight of traffic and this should be extended to housing along Green Lane. • Parking is restricted to the site only with no vehicles parked or queueing on High Street or Green Lane itself. • Vehicles have a Banksman to aid negotiation on Green Lane and High Street. • Electricity and Water/Sewerage supplies and their adequacy were challenged. <p>The PC will pursue a temporary parking embargo for the duration of the build with NCC along the length of Green Lane and the area which currently has Yellow Zig Zags.</p>
